Weekly Reflection.

Close to the Lord and alert for his coming.

Today's gospel says that when Jesus comes at the end, that will be harvest time. As we await that return of Jesus, the present is a time for growth and maturing, and opportunity to realize our potential. St Paul in one of his letters writes, "I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ," (Phil1:6)

The story is told of a nurse who worked in a hospital for lepers in the Philippines. She was renowned for the joy that she could not hide as she nursed the sick and the dying. When asked what her secret was, she said, "It took me 25 years to realize that God was in love with me and then all was changed. I begin each day with the words "Glory to God in the highest" and ask that I may live that today. "God's love, that is my joy." She had found a firm anchor in her life, an insight to be cherished, nourished and lived each day. It sustained her spirit of joy in demanding conditions. Close to the Lord, she was alert for his coming.

Echoes here in the nurse's story of the psalm from today's Mass:

O Lord, it is you who are my portion and cup;


It is you yourself who are my prize.

I keep the Lord ever in my sight:

Since he is at my right hand, I shall stand firm. (Psalm 15:5)
