Weekly Reflection.

'Sunday morning coming down.'

Kris Kristofferson, one of the greatest songwriters in American Country Music, died two weeks ago. I am very fond of his material. He wrote songs that had meaning and feeling within them, songs that were often made famous by some other artist. 'Sunday morning coming down' is one of my favourites, which was a big hit for the late Johnny Cash.

It tells of the loneliness of all those people who search for fulfilment, understanding or meaning in life in all the wrong places, through drink or drugs or as in the Gospel today, in wealth. The lyrics of the song identify the man in a dingy backroom drinking the cure, fumbling through dirty clothes, and stumbling to greet the day. This really contrasts with the images of individuals and families in their Sunday best, for whom Sunday is special, Sunday is all about love, warmth, and goodness. The isolation the singer feels causes him to lament that 'there's something in a Sunday that makes a body feel alone.'

We who have the gift of faith have a real blessing in our lives for Sunday is that special time when we are close to family, friends, and community, and especially to God. We do not need to feel alone.
