"Travelling Light"

When I was a child, I had an aunt who was unmarried who nursed in England. Each summer she would come home to stay with us. There would be great excitement in the days leading up to her arrival for as children we looked forward to her visit like that of a second Santa Claus. She would arrive and from the car she would produce anything up to seven or eight big red suitcases – she was only staying for a week – and each and every one of us would receive a present. May God be good to her, she never travelled light and would never have managed to be a passenger on the "no frills airlines of today."

Jesus tells us in the Gospel today to travel light – no purse, no haversack, no spare tunics – he is urging us to let go of worldly possessions – they are only a distraction. We must become generous and trusting if we are to achieve happiness and contentment, in this world and the next.
