#### Weekly Reflection

#### 'What class of an eejit are you?'

This question was often asked by my father when I or one of my siblings who while trying to be useful, would have managed to do harm with a tractor or some piece of machinery on the farm. Until then I had not been aware that there were different classes of eejit!

There are different classes of Catholics too. The journey through Advent provides us with a similar type of question. What class of a Catholic are you? John the Baptist spelled it out for his listeners who included tax-collectors and soldiers, if you have two tunics then share with the person who has none. The time of Christmas festivities provides a wonderful opportunity to be generous not just with those whom we love, but also to those who have little. We must move beyond the bottom class of safe, cosy swapping of presents and strive for the top of the class in charity to those whose needs are greatest.

**Jubilee Year of Hope 2025 – Resources now available Pope Francis has declared 2025 to be a Holy or Jubilee Year.** A Jubilee Year is one set aside by the Church as a time of special grace, to encourage us all to embark on pilgrimages, to repent for our sins, to forgive and be reconciled with one another and to renew the spiritual life. The theme for this forthcoming Holy Year will be **"Pilgrims of Hope"**, thus bringing to the fore the journey of life that we are all

on and our need to be people of hope, a hope rooted in the person of Jesus Christ. The Holy Year will begin on Christmas Eve when Pope Francis opens the Holy Door at St Peter's in Rome. Locally, it will be opened in our Diocese on Sunday 29 December — Feast of the Holy Family — when Bishop Larry will be Chief Celebrant of the 12.30pm Mass in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan.
