#### Wonder and Awe in God's presence.

Our young adults in sixth class are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation in early May. They are presently learning about the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit that they will receive on that day. One of those gifts is wonder and awe in God's presence. The three chosen disciples in the Gospel today experience a moment of wonder and awe on the mountain in the Transfiguration. They become tongue tied and mesmerised by the moment and wish to remain in that state of ecstasy forever. Jesus however brings them back to reality quite quickly, but the memory of the moment sustains the three in the later difficult days of the passion of Jesus.

All of us can share in the wonder and awe of God when we appreciate and celebrate all that is good in oneself, in others and in creation.

This gift of the Holy Spirit helps us to see the work of God in ordinary everyday things. It's in the beauty of spring and the buds and flowers of new growth all around us.
