Catholic Schools Week 19th – 25th January 2025: This year's theme for Catholic Schools Week is **"Alive in Christ"**. Reflecting on this theme, Catholic schools will explore what it means to be fully alive as a human being – living life to the full in Christ. Sensitive to the age appropriateness of the various classes and years, the theme will explore how we exist for one another in Christ, building from the wellbeing of the individual, extending the notion of true wellbeing to others, to our families and communities, and to The Other, in God. The theme will mediate on hope, the true purpose and meaning of human life, and, in the more senior years, on true freedom.

The Annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity: continues **until Saturday 25 January 2025**. This year of 2025, in addition to being a Jubilee Year based on the theme 'Pilgrims of Hope', is also the 1700th anniversary of the first Ecumenical Council of the Church, the Council of Nicaea, held in 325. That Council gave us the Nicene Creed which we profess on most Sundays and other Solemnities. Fittingly, the theme for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity this year is **"Do you believe this?"**, based on the Gospel of John 11:17-27 and Martha's confession of faith to Jesus. Within the Diocese of Clogher, St. Michael's Parish and Mgr Peter O'Reilly will host an event for Christian Unity week. It will be held on **Thursday 23rd January at 7.30pm in St. Michael's Church, Enniskillen**.



Jubilee Year of Hope 2025.

Pope Francis has declared 2025 to be a Holy or Jubilee Year. A Jubilee Year is one set aside by the Church as a time of special grace, to encourage us all to embark on pilgrimages, to repent for our sins, to forgive and be reconciled with one another and to renew the spiritual life. The theme for the Holy Year is **"Pilgrims of Hope,"** thus bringing to the fore the journey of life that we are all on and our need

to be people of hope, a hope rooted in the person of Jesus Christ. Pope Francis opened the Holy Door at St Peter's in Rome on Christmas Eve, marking the opening of the Jubilee Year. Some online resources for the Jubilee Year are now available on www.clogherdiocese.ie/jubilee2025.
