Weekly Reflection

Watch yourselves! Stay awake, praying at all times!

Our town kicked off the Christmas festive season with the colourful switching of Christmas lights on 22nd November. Now, the Christmas festive mood is in the air, and probably on top of our list are exchanging gifts, visiting family and friends, and shopping.

Today in the Church, we begin Advent, the season of preparation and anticipation for Christmas. In addition to the colourful lights in our town, the Church invites us to fix our gaze on the symbol of the Advent wreath, which stands for the immortality of our souls and Jesus' promise of eternal life, and on the five candles symbolising the light of Christ himself. With this focus in hindsight, the gospel today teaches us that Advent is a time to become spiritually awake.

Jesus says, "Stay awake, praying at all times! Stand erect; hold your heads high!" Thus, amidst the hustle and bustle of daily life, we need to pay close attention to God's presence and action in our lives here and now. Christ warns us to be careful lest our "hearts be weighed down with dissipation and drunkenness and worries of this life".

According to the gospel, the best Christmas festive mood is to **"see Christ more clearly, love him more dearly, and follow him more closely"** (St. Richard of Chichester). The rest will fall into place.
