Weekly Reflection.

"Anyone who wants to become great among you must be your servant."

In Isaiah 55,8, the Lord declares: "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways". This is the feeling that one gets in today's gospel. It is the third time that Jesus has revealed the type of Messiah he is to his disciples; sadly, with no desired response. Jesus is crystal clear about his Messiahship: "For the Son of man himself did not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Painfully His trusted friends (the disciples) do not buy into Jesus' idea of a Messiah. Instead, they still cling to the conventional notion of a powerful and political Messiah.

Such is the attitude behind James and John's (sons of Zebedee) demand to Jesus: "Allow us to sit one at your right hand and the other at your left in your glory." Just like the world today, James and John's demand is cloaked in ambition and an insidious appetite for power, status, influence, and domination.

Jesus' response is simple but tough: "Anyone who wants to become great among you must be slave to all". Thus, the logic of our Christian vocation is not power or domination but love and selfless service to humanity.

Let us take a cue from Rabindranath Tagore's phrase (Bengali poet): "I slept and dreamt that life was nothing but joy. I woke up and realised that life was only service. I served and I understood that service was joy."

World Mission Sunday: Today Sunday 20th October we celebrate World Mission Sunday it is a special day that unites Catholics worldwide in prayer, solidarity, and support for the Church's mission efforts. This year's theme, chosen by Pope Francis, is rooted in the Gospel of Matthew: "Go and Invite Everyone to the Banquet," reflecting the inclusive and urgent call to bring God's love to everyone. Donations are collected at the worldwide Masses, and they go, in their entirety, to support churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor.

Catholic Bishops Pastoral Letter Welcoming Migrants to Ireland: during the Autumn General Meeting of the Bishops' Conference, the bishops of Ireland published a pastoral letter on welcoming immigrants, entitled A Hundred Thousand Welcomes "A Hundred Thousand Welcomes" invites the faithful to reflect on how we welcome immigrants in contemporary Ireland, and the theme is informed by the parable of the Good Samaritan. The pastoral letter's call to action encourages people to welcome immigrants and strive to help all newcomers belong to the life of the community; to reject voices that sow division; and calls on State authorities to provide more resources to address local social and economic shortages that have been neglected for too long.
