Weekly Reflection.

'The bag apron'

Younger generations may never have heard of the farming utensil called the bag apron. In my youth this was a homemade garment that in springtime the farmer wore around his waist which could hold a large amount of potatoes for planting or seed for sowing. At the beginning of the activity the bag would be heavy and bursting at the seams as the farmer walked along scattering the seeds or dropping the potatoes. As the process involved walking considerable distances, it was important that as much as possible was poured into the apron each time it was filled.

In the Gospel today Jesus is encouraging his listeners to be enormously charitable and unstinting to those who are less well-off, because the reward from God, he assures us, will be an overwhelming abundance – a full measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over, will be poured into our lap.

God's unlimited bounties will be greater than any of us could carry in a bag apron, so let us be compassionate and generous.
