#### The King of Mercy

The Feast of Christ the King challenges us to focus on what type of society we would wish would belong to. Mercy is a term that has lost some of its significance as we have become wealthier and more individualistic in our lifestyles. Mercy primarily is proof that God loves us — our faith is an ongoing development of our relationship with him.

Traditionally we are called to exercise mercy by the seven Corporal Works of Mercy and the Seven Spiritual Works of Mercy. It might be no harm to remind ourselves of those:

### **Corporal Works of Mercy:**

to feed the hungry

to give drink to the thirsty

to clothe the naked

to welcome the stranger

to heal the sick

to visit the imprisoned

to bury the dead

### **Spiritual Works of Mercy:**

to counsel the doubtful

to instruct the ignorant

to admonish sinners

to comfort the afflicted

to forgive offences

to patiently bear those who do us ill.

to pray for the living and the dead.
