#### Weekly Reflection.

#### "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me"

The first reading and the gospel have some parallels or semblance. Just as Ezra solemnly reads a section from the Book of the Law to the Israelites, Jesus also reads the scroll of the Book of Isaiah to the Jews in the synagogue. Jesus made the words of Isaiah, his manifesto. He has come to replace the old Jewish law with a new law that directs attention to the sick, the poor, the oppressed, the marginalised, tax collectors, prostitutes and public sinners who are despised and rejected on moral grounds. He is on a holistic mission to save all.

The second reading explains why Jesus undertakes this comprehensive mission. Thus, we are all members of his body. Though many, we all form part of the body of Christ. Therefore, the weakest members are not less important and those perceived as least honourable should be treated with dignity.

We pray that we will clearly understand the mission of Jesus and make it our own.


