World Day of Peace is marked on 1st January each year, the Feast of Mary, Mother of God. The theme this year is **"Forgive us our trespasses: give us your peace"**. A copy of the Message for World Day of Peace from Pope Francis can be accessed via this link <u>Pope Francis' Message for the World Day of Peace 2025 - Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development</u> We are also mindful that this World Day of Peace comes at the beginning of a Jubilee Year of Hope. Pope Francis invites us to look at the many challenges that severely endanger the survival of humanity and Creation with a heart full of hope. In particular, the Holy Father recommends three actions that can truly mark a path of peace: the forgiveness of the international debt; the abolition of the death penalty; the establishment of a World Fund that will definitively eliminate hunger.



Jubilee Year of Hope 2025.

Pope Francis has declared 2025 to be a Holy or Jubilee Year. A Jubilee Year is one set aside by the Church as a time of special grace, to encourage us all to embark on pilgrimages, to repent for our sins, to forgive and be reconciled with one another and to renew the spiritual life. The theme for this forthcoming Holy Year will be **"Pilgrims of Hope"**, thus bringing to the fore the journey of life that we are all

on and our need to be people of hope, a hope rooted in the person of Jesus Christ. The Holy Year will begin on Christmas Eve when Pope Francis opens the Holy Door at St Peter's in Rome. Locally, it will be opened in our Diocese today Sunday 29 December — Feast of the Holy Family — when Bishop Larry will be Chief Celebrant of the 12.30pm Mass in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan.
