## Weekly Reflection.

### 'Do we still believe in miracles?'

In the Gospel today we read an account of a miracle. This time it is the cure of the daughter of Jairus, who was extremely sick, indeed she was dying. The father pleads with Jesus to come and turn back the tide of illness. But it looked as if it was too late. The girl had died.

Jesus was undaunted and prayed over the girl and the miracle happened – she was returned to her family. It was to be a sign – that Christ was truly the Son of God.

In our society and indeed in our church our outlook on life seems very one-sided where we have lost our sense of compassion for the poor, the underprivileged, the refugees. A sense of entitlement and selfishness leaves us in a bad place where we look out for ourselves and ignore the needs of others. It would take a miracle to turn this around. But if each one of us worked our own little miracle by way of love and service then by benefitting one lonely person, helping one member of my family, supporting one charity, saving one victim of famine, then a miracle can still happen.

Each of us is called to produce reserves of compassionate care and by our generosity you and I can restore life to other people just as Jesus restored life today.
