Weekly Reflection.

A hundred thousand welcomes?

It would have been so much easier if when Jesus was asked which is the greatest commandment if he had answered 'love God' and left it at that. Instead, he added the 'love your neighbour' as an equally important clause, and ever since we have struggled with this second answer.

The recent Irish Bishops Pastoral, entitled 'A hundred thousand welcomes?' challenges us to consider how we relate to the new arrivals in our country and communities. These arrivals have certainly exposed the failings of our society in terms of housing, homelessness, and social/health services, but are not the cause of these inadequacies. Ireland's history from famine times through every generation has seen our people forced to emigrate. We have an innate and deep-seated understanding of the plight of the Irish who left these shores to find a better life and are conscious of their experiences of not always receiving a welcome. Now as others come to our shores seeking refuge as migrants from war, famine, or injustice, we are surely called to a spirit of openness, encounter, and hospitality.

It is not always easy, but it is the Christian way – 'Love your neighbour.'

SYNOD on SYNODALITY - **The final document** from the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod has been published and is available below as a working translation in English. In a departure from usual practice, Pope Francis said, "I want... to recognise the value of the completed synodal journey, which through this document I hand over to the holy faithful people of God.... There are already very concrete indications in the document that can be a guide for the mission of the Churches, on the different continents, in the different contexts: that is why I am making it immediately available to everyone."
