#### Weekly Reflection.

#### The Food that endures.

There was a popular story about a Zambian Politician who visited South Africa in 1980. Recall that South Africa was going through apartheid and racial segregation. This Politician called on South African youths to give up their anti-apartheid struggle. His reason was that since Zambia had Black majority rule and its economy was in shambles, and South Africa had White minority rule and its economy was doing much better, they should give up their struggle for Black majority rule unless they wanted to be poor like Zambia. But one of the youths replied, 'Why don't we lock you up in prison and then give you everything you want to eat and drink, but still keep you locked up in prison.' Immediately he got the point.

Beloved in Christ, this is to tell us that the human soul hungers for something beyond food and drink. Even when we have all the material foods in the world while lacking spiritual food, our hunger remains unsatisfied, and our hearts remain restless. In today's gospel, Jesus tells the crowd that they are following him for the wrong reasons – because he filled their stomachs. There is no doubt we need our daily bread to live but we cannot live by this bread alone. We need the food of eternal life which Jesus gives us in sacrament of the Eucharist. But too often, we don't ask for it instead we seek the perishable foods of our everyday wants and anxieties.

Jesus reminds us, 'Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you' (John 6, 27).
