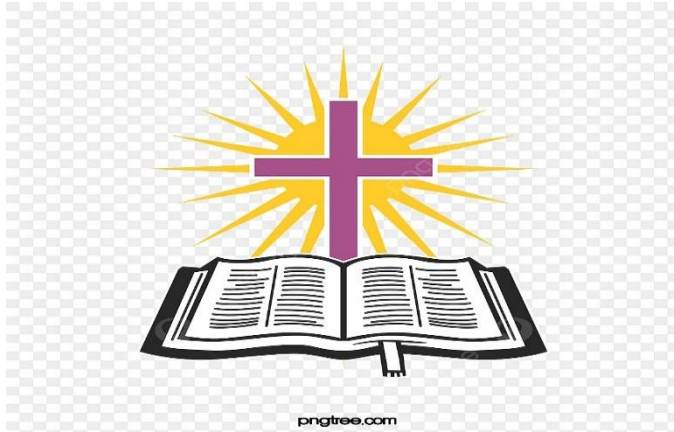

Weekly Reflection.

"Blinded by familiarity"

The townspeople of Jesus were unable to accept that he could be a messenger from God, let alone God's own Son. They were blinded by familiarity.

Occasionally we fail to recognise the true greatness of those with whom we live most closely. It is hard to recognise the genuine follower of Christ when they are a member of our family or a member of our community, who strives to care for the elderly parent, or the ailing spouse, or the child with special needs. We all know such people who give of themselves totally and completely for the vulnerable person. Perhaps we ignore, ridicule, or dismiss a person because of their generosity of time & energy because of our own inadequacy in that regard.

Jesus could do no miracles due to the reactions of the people of his community because of their lack of faith – he can only perform miracles where there is faith. We pray for that faith that enables miracles of healing and love to happen in our families and our community.
