Weekly Reflection

Prepare a way for the Lord!

Today's gospel (Sunday) introduces the prophetic figure of John the Baptist. In him the prophetic voice that had been silent for centuries comes alive again.

John concentrates on how the human heart can best prepare for the coming of the Messiah. He takes the imagery of Isaiah, of mountains being levelled, valleys filled in, crooked ways being straightened. The landscape of the heart requires re-ordering. The heart has its own no-go areas, its roundabouts, its mountainous places, its deep valleys, its cul-de-sacs, its potholes, etc. These need to be smoothed with care if the coming Christ is to find a warm Christmas welcome. Advent offers us a space to attend to some of the "road works" that ought to be done in preparation for his arrival.

Therefore, let us make of this our prayer for the remaining weeks of Advent:

God of our salvation, you straighten the winding ways of our hearts and smooth the paths made rough by sin. Make our conduct blameless, keep our hearts watchful in holiness, and bring to perfection the good you have begun in us. We ask this through Him whose coming is certain, whose day draws near: your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God for ever and ever. Amen.
