#### Weekly Reflection.

'Glory be'

The Feast of the Trinity brings us to the central tenet of our faith. Belief in a God made up of three distinct persons is an article of our faith that we almost take for granted, but which can present all sorts of conundrums and challenges for unbelievers.

I was in a house recently where the two children aged five and eight were demonstrating to me their newfound confidence in making the sign of the cross. All went well for touching the forehead for the Father and touching the chest for the Son, but when it came to the Holy Spirit, they looked to each other for guidance for they were not sure whether to go left shoulder first, or right shoulder first. It brought me back to my own childhood and similarly demonstrating for a visitor and the stress of trying to get it right when the pride of the family was at stake!

The mystery of the Trinity is for theologians and philosophers to argue about. I am quite content with praying; Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end, Amen.
